

Concept Note

Since 2012, the DAAD Regional Office Cairo has been organising its annual highlight event the German Science Day. This event, which currently takes place in the framework of COSIMENA, aims to give doctoral and post-doctoral candidates from Egypt and Sudan insights into the German research landscape and connect them with representatives of German universities as well as DAAD alumni.

The DAAD Regional Office Cairo along with its network offers young researchers a unique opportunity to get scientific advice for doing doctoral and post-doctoral studies in Germany.

The diverse program of the German Science Week includes different formats such as presentations of German universities, scientific talks, panel discussions, success stories from DAAD alumni and soft-skills modules. DAAD staff also provide an overview of the German research landscape and funding opportunities from the DAAD. The German Science Week facilitates the exchange between promising doctoral and post-doctoral candidates and professors, scientists and experts from Germany and Egypt.

Clusters of Scientific Innovation in the Middle East and North Africa

In the scope of COSIMENA, the DAAD Regional Office Cairo realises interdisciplinary events on current issues in science and innovation, such as workshops, conferences, roundtable discussions, the German Science Day, the COSIMENA Science Night and a Summer School. The several activities aim to bring together various stakeholders from science, business, government, and civil society. Especially young scientists are promoted and supported through networking opportunities.

Online Counselling

One of the pillars of the DAAD Regional Office Cairo's activities is the counseling service for students and researchers who are interested in studying and researching at German institutions for Higher Education and research. Our counseling services are two-folded, each aiming at a different target group: First, the Online Information Session for Undergraduates which targets those who want to enroll in a bachelor's programme in Germany. Second, the Online Individual Counselling for Postgraduates intends to provide advice for scholars who already achieved an academic degree and want to engage in a master's or PhD programme, conduct Postdoctoral research or teach at a university in Germany. Scientific Talk (30 minutes)	Our scientific talks deal with different global challenges; like climate change; especially the ones related to the different issue- driven clusters: agriculture, cultural heritage, economy, energy, health, urbanism and water.

Soft Skills Mini- Modules (45 minutes)	Due to the great need and demand for skill enhancement and capacity building among academics in Egypt, the DAAD Regional Office Cairo offers various modules by professional trainers to help strengthen Egyptian students and researchers in international competition by offering opportunities for further training rarely found in universities and research institutions. These Mini-Modules give young researchers insights into the necessary soft skills which are prerequisites to pursue an academic career in Germany. A "Q & A-session" is included.
Panel Discussion (60 minutes)	It is a "live ", in-person or virtual discussion about the academic career at the times post-pandemic and crisis in Europe amongst a group of experts from the German Embassy, the DAAD, the German Universities who share facts and offer differing perspectives about the topic and provide useful information for researchers who are planning to continue part of their academic career in Germany. The Panel Discussion is facilitated by a "moderator". The questions were collected before the event.
